Coach Wall was head coach at Winnebago, Illinois and Roseville Illinois before coming to Preble in 1969. He has compiled 33 years of coaching high school basketball.

Wall retired from Green Bay Preble High School. During his tenure, his teams recorded 294 wins and 261 losses. They won five conference championships, eight WIAA Regional championships, five WIAA Sectional championships and five WIAA State Tournament appearances. Twice Coach Wall's team reached the semifinals of the WIAA State Tournament. His overall coaching record is 340 wins and 290 losses.

Coach Wall's philosophy was to have a sound offensive and defensive system based on the development of players of specific individual skills that were practiced enough to be habit. The emphasis was placed on ball control and style of play.

Keith Wall was a very active member of the Wisconsin Basketball Coaches Association. He was the head coach of the North All-Star Team in 1982. He was also involved with the player selection committee and raised funds for the WBCA.

Some of the many recognitions given Coach Wall throughout the years were being selected as Coach of the Year in the Fox River Valley Conference in 1975, 1985, 1988, 1991 and 1994. He was also selected Coach of the Year by the Metro-Press Gazette and News Chronicle the same years. He was also inducted into the Wisconsin Basketball Association Hall of Fame on September 27, 1997.

Coach Wall was not only a superb coach technically and in teaching team basketball, but he was a man of great integrity and character. He had a profound influence on the lives of the many students he taught and coached.
