Lee Fredrickson began his football coaching career in 1971 at Edison Jr. High. Lee's coaching career spanned 32 years at Preble from 1971-2002. Not only did Coach Fred help produce the success at Edison, but he also volunteered with the Preble varsity program in various capacities, earning an invitation to coach at the varsity level at Preble.

Lee became the #1 assistant to Coach Pat Prochnow, who proceeded Bill Dessart as head coach, a coaching team that lasted for more than 25 years. Lee was always considered to be more of a co-coach than an assistant. Lee was excellent in coaching and teaching the sport, but also in teaching the student athletes the positive lessons of life that help a young person succeed in sport and life.

In the offseason, Lee commitment countless hours to the summer and winter weightlifting and conditioning program, encouraging student athletes to improve their physical, mental, and emotional skills continuing, after retirement, to assist the program in various.

Lee was a part of the success of the Preble football team achieving 9 conference championships, 12 playoff berths, 4 State Semi Final appearances, and racking up 169 wins during his career. Lee also received such honors as conference assistant Coach of the Year and State District 10 Coach of the Year. Lee was recognized with awards from the Green Bay Area Chamber of Commerce, the Wisconsin Council on Economic Education as a 1985 teacher of the year, and the National Joint Council on Economic Development.
